Summary of the activity and results obtained in the project in 2025

Project name: "Climate reporting and its role in achieving sustainable development: a multidimensional approach to drivers, obstacles and possible outcomes"

The first phase of the project "Climate Reporting and its role in achieving sustainable development: a multidimensional approach to drives, obstacles and possible outcomes" (CLEAR-INNOVATE) took place from 1 September 2025 to 31 December 2025 and had as its fundamental scientific objective the establishment of the coordinates of the documentation regarding the recent stage of the conceptual framework related to the topic under consideration.

This objective was achieved through documentation and literature review activities regarding: the key concepts involved (e.g. non-financial reporting, sustainability reporting, climate change reporting, sustainable development); the assessment and measurement of the different dimensions of climate change reporting; institutional analysis and analysis of existing regulatory frameworks.

Additionally, this stage aimed to integrate researchers from the Republic of Moldova into the scientific community of UVT, as well as to capitalize on the expertise potential of the members of the mixed team (UVT-Romania and ASEM - Republic of Moldova).

The objectives and activities of this stage resulted in the following:

- 3 manuscripts dedicated to the dissemination of research results involving bibliometric analyses (performed in a mixed team);
- 1 article accepted for publication in a collective volume (performed in a mixed team);
- 3 participations/communications at international scientific conferences;
- 4 research internships in Romania (ICAM-UVT) for the team from the Republic of Moldova;
- 1 hybrid training on research methodology (28 participants from UVT, ASEM, UAV, UAB);
- 1 mind map (outline) addressing the differences between sustainability reporting and climate change-related reporting;
- 1 lean model canvas on existing regulatory frameworks;
- 2 participations in winter schools dealing with interdisciplinary research topics;
- 2 participations in the sessions of the first edition of the "Alumni Diaspora UVT"
 Conference;
- 2 courses of the Doctoral School of Economics and Business Administration within UVT SDEAA UVT facilitated access for researchers from the Republic of Moldova to relevant information related to the research topic;
